Literacy & Communication	<u>Diary</u> Keep a diary of how the area around you changes during the day, eg. Is it busier at different times?	<u>Report</u> Write a report about your local area - what do you think about the environment around your home? Take a walk and investigate.	<u>Top Trumps</u> Research different cities in the United Kingdom and produce a set of Top Trump cards showing population, shops, places of interest etc.
Maths & Problem Solving	<u>Rap!</u> Create a rap about time e.g. months of the year, or days of the week etc.	<u>Wordsearch</u> Make a wordsearch using all the vocabulary that has anything to do with multiplication and division.	<u>Eco-Friendly Survey</u> Collect and present data to show how you recycle rubbish from your house - use tally charts or bar charts to help you.
Science and the Outside Environment	<u>Cooking related to solids, liquids and gases</u> Explain what happens when you cook something, e.g. a cake or make toast.	<u>Water Cycle</u> Explain what happens to water when you boil a kettle and make an ice cube.	<u>Decibel Chart</u> Make a chart to show how sound is measured in decimals. What sounds like 30 dB, or 100 dB?
Humanities and Citizenship	<u>Amenities Fact File</u> Look around where you live, what amenities can you see, eg. Post Office, shop, swimming pool etc.	<u>Changes</u> What would you change in your local environment to improve it? Eg. More trees, a playground etc. Create a map with your improvements.	<u>Map Work</u> Locate monuments in different counties and cities in the UK and mark them on a map.
Creative Arts	<u>Christmas Poem</u> Create a Christmas card to symbolise the lights at this time, with a poem to express your feelings.	<u>Bonfire Night Collage</u> Create a collage using the materials of your choice.	<u>Fairy Tale Character</u> Produce a portrait of your favourite character using a variety of materials.
