CLASS: Reception

In Reception we encourage learning through the child's interests. The children will be observed regularly and these will feed into the planning focusing on their next steps.

IN LITERACY I WILL BE ...

- Listening to, sequencing and retelling stories about Percy the Park and The Jolly Postman.
- Learning to say, hear, read and write my sounds in phonics.
- Reading and discussing shared books in guided reading.

IN MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT I WILL BE ...

- Learning to spot and name 2d and 3d shapes and learning to use language related to money.
- Learning to read, write and order numbers. We will learn to say the number 1 more and 1 less, and to add and subtract small numbers by counting on or back.

IN PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT I WILL BE ...

- Continuing to develop our new friendships
- Learning to recognise and respond to the feelings of others.

IN PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT I WILL BE ...

- Learning to use tools, objects and materials safely and with increasing control.
- Getting better at holding a pencil effectively to form recognisable letters.
- Exploring different ways to move and learning to use space safely.
- Learning ways to stay safe when approaching new challenges in school, at home and out and about.

IN COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE I WILL BE...

 Developing my language skills by listening to and telling stories about people who help us and through our role-play.

IN UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD I WILL BE ...

- Learning about different occupations and ways of life. We will be learning about family and religious traditions and celebrations.
- Observing changes in the weather and seasons. We will learn about what we can do to help animals and birds over the winter months.
- Practising using the computers to complete games and activities.

IN EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN I WILL BE ...

- Exploring and using materials We will
 make something to help animals in
 Winter e.g. a home for an animal or a
 bird feeder. We will try out our ideas
 to help us choose how to make them
 and what to use.
- Being imaginative We will create our own Christmas pictures and other crafts.
