Understanding of the World

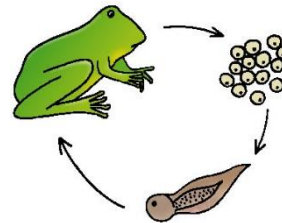
People and Communities – They know that other children don't always enjoy the same things, and are sensitive to this

Expressive arts and design

They represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and drama

Maths

They recognise, create and describe patterns. They explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
