We will keep working on recognising and responding to other people's feelings.

Physical Development

Moving and Handling

We will learn to use tools, objects and materials safely and with increasing control. We will get better at holding a pencil effectively to form recognisable letters. We will be exploring different ways to move and learning to use space safely.

Health and Self-Care

We will practise sequencing and explaining our ideas.

Literacy
