**As athletes we will:**

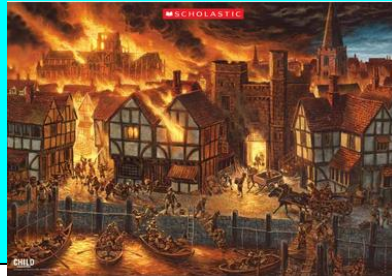
Develop our core strength and upper body movement.
