Rivers and the Water Cycle

As geographers we will:

- Learn about the course of a river from source to mouth including looking at the human and physical geography.
- Locate rivers around the UK, finding the names and the different lengths.
- Discover the different features from source to mouth.

In English...

As an author we will:

- Learn and create our own narrative poem.
- Write a non-chronological report.
- Write to persuade.

IN SCIENCE WE WILL BE LEARNING ABOUT...

Electricity

As Scientists we will:

- Identify common appliances that run on electricity.
- Construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers.
- Identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery.
- Recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate this with whether or not a lamp lights in a simple series circuit.
- Recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.

In Maths...

As Mathematicians we will:

- Understand place value and the value of each digit.
- Learn about number sense and how number works in real life situations.
- Use all calculation methods of 3/4 digit numbers using a written method.
- Solving problems involving measures.
- Investigating data.
- Participate in Times Table Rockstars daily.
