IN SCIENCE I WILL BE LEARNING ABOUT

Animals and Humans and Living things and their habitats

As Scientists we will...

- Describe the simple functions of the parts of the digestive system in humans
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.
- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

In Maths

As Mathematicians we will:

- Understand fractions, recognise equivalent fractions, fractions of shapes and amounts and add and subtract fractions.
- Focus on the four operations of numbers and developing methods to calculate these.
- Calculating change and amounts of money in real life situations.
- Measuring the area and perimeter of shapes.
- Measuring volume and capacity of liquids.
- Solving real life problems using the four operations.
- TT Rockstars to develop instant recall of times table.
