

## Year 1 Homework - Autumn 1

Below is a list of activities for your child to do over the next half term. The activities are linked to our topic: All about me. It would be great if they could do at least 1 Literacy, and 1 Maths Activity. They can then choose 1 or more other activities from the grid. Please can they bring completed homework in on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October.

<b>Literacy 1</b> Write a postcard to somebody to tell them about your Summer holiday.	<b>Literacy 2</b> Draw a picture of yourself and label the main body parts.	<b>Literacy 3</b> Write a description about yourself or somebody in your family.	<b>Literacy 4</b> Retell your favourite story and talk about the characters and setting. Can you add actions to the story?
<b>Maths 1</b> Use different body parts to make addition sums. e.g. 2 eyes and 2 ears = 4.	<b>Maths 2</b> Look at house numbers as you walk around Thirsk and say the numbers out loud.	<b>Maths 3</b> Practise counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.	<b>Maths 4</b> Practise your number bonds to 5 and 10. e.g. $4 + 6 = 10$ , $3 + 7 = 10$ . The farmer Pete song on you tube is very good for this.
<b>Reading 1</b> Choose a book to read and explain why you chose it. How did you make your choice?	<b>Reading 2</b> Draw a scene from the story and label four features on it. (eg snowy mountain, deep blue sea, tall, wavy grass)	<b>Reading 3</b> Write a book review about a book you have read. Title, author, fiction/non-fiction, what the book was about and if you liked it, or not.	<b>Reading 4</b> Make a book for someone to read. Think about who your book will be for.
<b>Topic 1</b> Look at pictures of you as a baby and talk about how you have changed over the years.	<b>Topic 2</b> Make a timeline of toys you have played with through the years.	<b>Topic 3</b> Ask a parent or a grandparent to tell you what it was like when they were 5. What things are the same? What is different?	<b>Topic 4</b> Paint a picture or make a collage of your family.
