Create a story about your journey.	<b>Literacy 3</b>  Create a poster advertising a brand new type of transport.	<b>Literacy 4</b>  Write all the words you can think of containing the 'ed' suffix.
<b>Reading 1</b>  List four features of non-fiction books.	<b>Reading 2</b>  Choose a book to read and explain why you chose it. How did you make your choice?	<b>Reading 3</b>  Find three words in a dictionary beginning with <b>t</b> , three beginning with <b>g</b> and three beginning with <b>h</b> .	<b>Reading 4</b>  Order three events in the story.  First... Then... After that...
<b>Maths 1</b>  Draw three types of transport? Measure them using centimetres. How tall are they? Which one is the tallest? Which one is the shortest?	<b>Maths 2</b>  Practise doubling and halving numbers to 20.	<b>Maths 3</b>  Use 1 tube of Smarties; how many sets of 2 sweets can you make? How many sets of 5? Sets of 3?	<b>Maths 4</b>  Practise telling o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times.
<b>Topic 1</b>  Make a vehicle out of old boxes or construction materials at home.	<b>Topic 2</b>  Design a flying machine.	<b>Topic 3</b>  Can you identify objects around your home and identify what material they are made from? For example what material is a fork made out of?	<b>Topic 4</b>  Paint, colour, pastel or draw a busy road scene.
