<p>Reading 1 Can you find words containing the suffixes 'er' in your book and write these down.</p>	<p>Reading 2 Visit the library and borrow a book on toys. Can you write down three facts you have discovered?</p>	<p>Reading 3 Create a new front cover for one of your books.</p>	<p>Reading 4 Select a character from your story and describe them.</p>
<p>Maths 1 Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.</p>	<p>Maths 2 Learn the months of the year. Can you think of important things that happen in each month? E.g. Christmas is in December, Halloween is in October.</p>	<p>Maths 3 Make arrays at home to represent multiplication sums. E.g. an egg box represents $6 \times 2 = 12$.</p>	<p>Maths 4 Find different ways to share a certain group of objects. E.g. can you share 10 into 2 groups, 5 groups?</p>
<p>Topic 1 Ask a member of your family to talk about the toys they played with when they were little.</p>	<p>Topic 2 Can you create an alphabet of toys? E.g. 'a' is for abacus, b is for ball.</p>	<p>Topic 3 Make a Christmas card or decoration.</p>	<p>Topic 4 Create your own puppet using any materials you would like.</p>
