Try to use time connectives - first, next, then, after that, finally.</p>	<p>Literacy 3</p> <p>Write a list of all of the plants and flowers you can think of.</p>	<p>Literacy 4</p> <p>Write at least 3 facts about castles.</p>
<p>Reading 1</p> <p>Read a leaflet for a tourist attraction. How is it laid out? What features does it have?</p>	<p>Reading 2</p> <p>Read and follow a recipe and pick out all of the imperative verbs (doing words). Can you write these down?</p>	<p>Reading 3</p> <p>Make up your own story set in a castle. What characters will be in?</p>	<p>Reading 4</p> <p>Pick a character from your book, draw it and write adjectives to describe your character.</p>
<p>Maths 1</p> <p>Partition numbers up to 10 in different ways. e.g. $9 = 5 + 4$, $6 + 3$, $7 + 2$, $8 + 1$.</p>	<p>Maths 2</p> <p>Solve practical problems involving addition and subtraction. E.g. I have 3 cars and you have 4 cars. How many do we have altogether?</p>	<p>Maths 3</p> <p>How many ways can you find to make 10p? Is there more or less ways to make 20p? How do you know?</p>	<p>Maths 4</p> <p>Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's forwards and backwards.</p>
<p>Topic 1</p> <p>Create a 3d model of a castle.</p>	<p>Topic 2</p> <p>Practise observational drawing skills. Look at something really carefully as you draw it.</p>	<p>Topic 3</p> <p>Visit a castle or the site of the old castle in Thirsk and talk about the key features of castles.</p>	<p>Topic 4</p> <p>Draw a castle and label the key features.</p>
